

TO'HAJIILEE EARLY CHILDHOOD COORDINATED SERVICES

TO'HAJIILEE is a Navajo community located off interstate I-40, exit 131, approximately 40 miles west of Albuquerque.

Katrina Nez is the Early Childhood Coordinator at the To'Hajiilee Community School. She coordinates services for children with developmental delays birth through five and their families. She coordinates Child Find Screenings, provides parent trainings and parent education resources, conducts health fairs, offers family services to those in need and follows the child as they transition into kindergarten.

Each year during March, disabilities month, the Community Outreach Committee sponsors a collection of toys, clothing, hygiene supplies, diapers, formula and baby food for the infants and toddlers of To'Hajiilee. Throughout the year, the Quilters of All Saints provide handmade quilts for this group.
