Welcome to our first hybrid event during COVID!!!! Here is what we are asking you to do:

1. Think about what you want your rock to say and look like. There are tons of ideas on Pinterest. Use your cell phone or computer to search “inspirational rocks”. There are all kinds of ideas for background designs and words or phrases.
2. Grab your supplies – a rock, a plate with acrylic paint, a paintbrush or two, fabric paint and/or paint pens to write words – sharpies would work also if you have a white rock.
3. On the back side of the rock write the words:
#ASLCRocks -and-
www.allsaintsabq.org
If the rock is small, you can leave the website off, but each rock should have the #ASLCRocks.
4. On the front of the rock, design and paint the background first with acrylic paint. You can use the non-brush side to make dots.
5. Let the paint dry.
6. Once the paint is dry you can use the fabric paint to write your message.
7. Let that dry before you touch it too much or put it out.

Once you are happy with your rock, take it home. Before you place it somewhere, take a picture and post it on our Facebook page with the words “#ASLCRocks”. Be sure to include the hashtag. The cards explain how and where to post, as well as suggested wording if you’d like.

Then go out and place your rock somewhere visible. My favorite part of my morning walk is looking for my rocks. It makes me very excited when it disappears.

The goal is that people will find the rocks and go check out the hashtag. Which will lead them to our website. Once at the website, there is a button that leads to a Faith Formation page.

Let’s see how far our inspiration and love for Jesus will travel.
