The Great Thanksgiving




The Lord be with you. And al - so with you.

Send us forth, burning with justice, peace, and love.

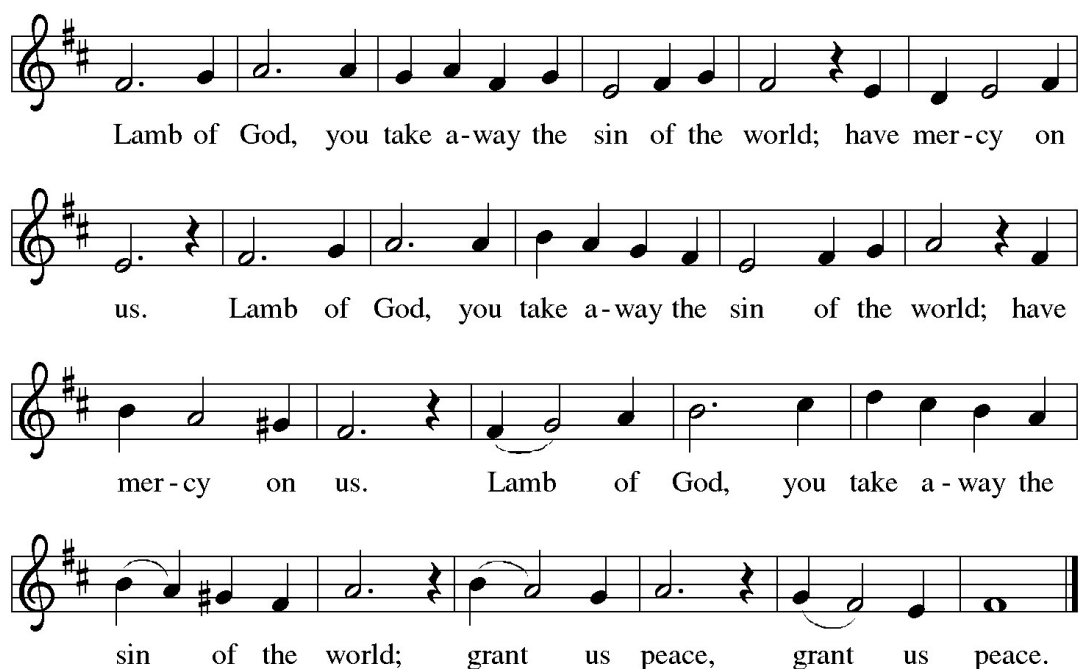
We praise you, O God, blessed and holy Trinity, now and forever.
