Offering Prayer

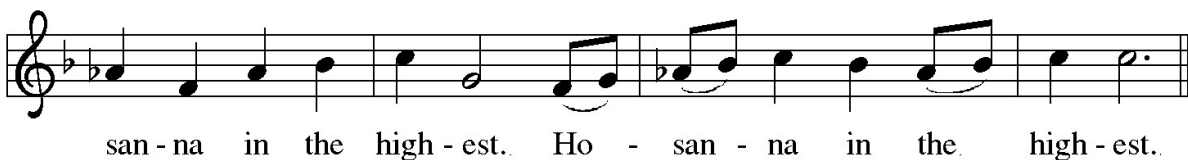
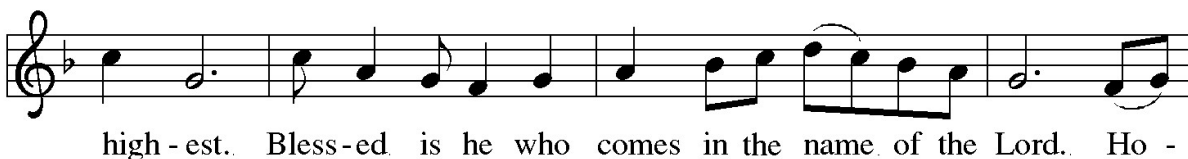
