**Forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us.**

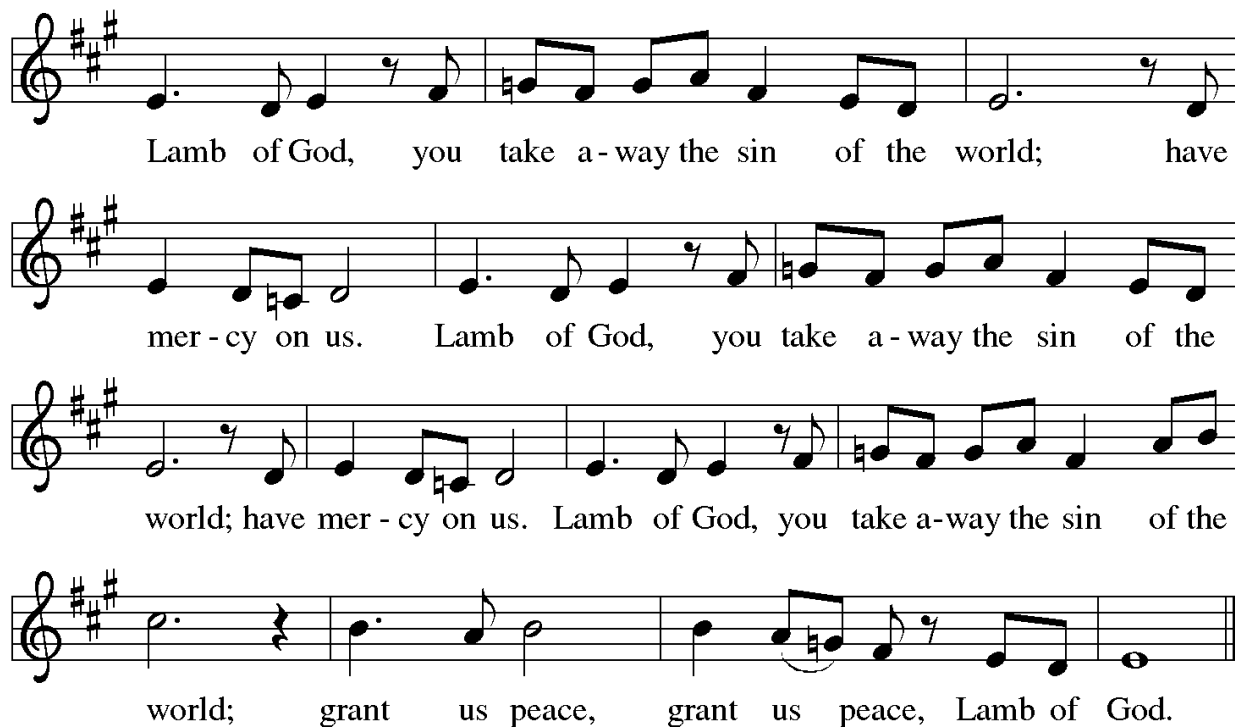
**Save us from the time of trial, and deliver us from evil.**
